The Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund (GRMF) is an international award in tribute to Dr Gustav Rosenberger and is related to the World Association for Buiatrics. The award was initiated, with the objective to 'further improve bovine medicine at an international level and to stimulate bovine research in its broadest sense'. To realize that objective, bovine scientists have been awarded by grants and prizes, mainly being young scientists.
